And a quick reference sheet to popular wines and what they should smell and taste like along with some easy food pairings.

Colour, aroma and flavour

COLOUR

As wines get older, they oxidize, turning slightly brown, just like an apple slice left on the counter. This is not necessarily a bad thing, and often adds to the complexities of a wine's character.

AROMA & FLAVOUR

Generally speaking, wines should have a mix of aromas and flavours. White wines usually have citrus notes, and red wines have berry notes. It's rare to have it the other way. Additionally, as wines age they move from fresh aromas and flavours, to dried. For example, plum may be present in youth and prune as the wine ages. It's not like a light switch, one day fresh the next dried. It's more like a mixing board on a stereo. In well-aged wines drinking in their prime, there will be an intriguing mix of fresh flavours fading into aged. This is part of the complexity of good wines.

FRUIT

- Citrus** lemon, lime, orange, grapefruit
- Orchard** apple, pear, grape
- Stone** peach, nectarine, apricot
- Tropical** pineapple, mango, passionfruit, kiwi, guava
- Berry** (red) cherry, strawberry, raspberry, currant // (black) cassis, cherry, blackberry, blueberry, currant
- Dried** fig, date, prune, raisin, (plus cooked, preserves or jam)

SPICE/OAK:

- Sweet spice** cinnamon, clove, ginger
- Savoury spice** black pepper, white pepper, liquorice, dried spices
- Nut** almond, hazelnut, coconut
- Coffee** espresso, coffee bean, mocha, chocolate

EARTH/MINERALITY/OTHER

- Floral** violet, rose, lavender, lilac
- Mineral** rock, flint, chalk, seashell
- Earth** soil, tar, forest, ash, steel, petrol, rubber
- Dairy** butter, yogurt, yeast, bread, pastry
- Oak** vanilla, smoke, charred wood, cedar
- Age** leather, barnyard, mushroom, game, wet leaves, dried fruits

VEGETAL

- Herbs** basil, cilantro, lemon grass, mint, lavender, bay leaf, thyme (fresh or dried?)
- Vegetable** green pepper, tomato plant, black olive, green olive, asparagus
- Leaf** grass, tree leaf, tobacco leaf

Popular Wine Descriptors and What They Really Mean

There are loads of wine descriptors, but in our experience hosting hundreds of wine tastings over the years, these are the most common, and confusing, for wine drinkers. We've tried to make these explanations as clear as Cabernet, but the reality is tasting is the best way to learn.

ACID An integral component to a wine's structure. This creates a sensation of mouth-watering and pinching the insides of your cheeks, like you just sucked on a lemon. Acidity is crucial to wine, though some wines might have more and some might have less, all good wines will have some element of acid. It keeps the wine focused, tight and in-line, like a new pair of Spanx. Not enough, and the wine lacks focus, or is out of balance.

OAK Poor oak. It seems to be the whipping boy for any wine someone doesn't like – whether that wine is oaked or not. Be careful when throwing this term around. When a wine has oak notes it means that there's a flavour or aroma of char, wood or toast, or sweet spice like vanilla, coconut or butterscotch.

TANNIN Tannin is a structural component in wine – particularly red wines – and leaves a drying sensation in your mouth like you have been eating cotton balls. There can also be a bitter flavour which might be unpleasant on its own, but in combination with the wine's other flavours can add a pleasing complexity (black tea, dark chocolate and walnut skins also have tannins, so you see what we mean about bitter and drying). Tannins in wine come from grape skins, which is why they're mostly found in red wines, and sometimes from oak barrels. Some red wines have very light tannin and some very firm. Generally speaking, a wine that has really aggressive tannin makes it a good candidate for long-term aging, as even the most beastly tannin will soften with age.

SWEET Oh, this is such a minefield for wine lovers. And it's understandable as it can be a totally confusing. It helps to start at the beginning. To make wine you need to have sugar (the sugar that's found in the grapes) so you can turn it into alcohol. And pretty much all wines, even the driest of the dry, have some left over sugar, or residual sugar, in them. Dry wines can have up to 10 grams of sugar per litre, and it's not at all perceptible on your tongue. At a certain amount that *residual sugar* becomes perceptible making the wine off dry, and in even greater amounts sweet. Where this can get confusing is a lot of dry wines have lots of very fruity flavours, or strong oak notes. These wines still have low residual sugar, so they're dry, but with lots of flavour.

DRY The yin to sweet's yang, dry wines lack of sweetness, or have very low residual sugar.

BODY The body of a wine comes primarily from alcohol and is either light, medium or full on your palate. To get a sense of this, think of the weights of water, milk and cream in your mouth.

LEGS/TEARS Legs and tears can be used interchangeably, and oh, how wine lovers love to talk about them. Tears are those little streaks that run down the side of your wine glass. It's a bit complicated and very science-y, but all you need to know is that tears are an indicator of how much alcohol and glycerol is in your glass. Try swirling a port and then swirling a glass of water to see for yourself. However, this is not a clear case of quality, and in reality, not a lot of wine pros really talk about them unless there's something exceptional going on. It's kindof like the moon: it's always there, but you only talk about it when it's really bright or really full or really spectacular. So take this as a warning: if some wine snob waxes poetic about the legs, chances are good he has no idea what he's talking about. So don't be that guy.

BALANCE This is the interchange between wine's acid, sugar, tannin, and alcohol. If everyone's playing nicely together and one element doesn't obviously stick out from the others, we say a wine's in balance. Like spokes on a bike wheel.

FAULTED Let's get one thing straight. Just because you don't like a wine, does not mean it's bad. When we're talking about a wine that is faulted, we're talking about an actual problem with the wine itself. There's a surprising number of things that can go wrong with a wine, none of them desirable. Aromas and flavours like nail polish remover, wet dog, egg salad, vinegar, cooked vegetables, musty basement... these are all *no bueno* and you should probably take back your wine.

CORKED Just because a wine is closed with a cork, does not mean it's corked. To call a wine corked, means there is something unhealthy happening in the wine. To be official, this is called TCA – or 2, 4, 6-Trichloroanisole if you really want to sound like you know what you're doing. It's not going to harm you, but it's not pleasant. A wine that's corked has aromas of wet cardboard, musty basement or wet dog, and those unattractive smells cover up any of the nice fruit or spice or florals the winemaker intended. Take it back!

Grape Descriptions

There are approximately 3,000 wine grapes in the world, but only a handful of what are considered "Noble Varietals." These are the grapes that now have ubiquitous presence in vineyards around the world, having been taken from their ancestral homeland (mostly France) centuries ago by intrepid winemakers looking for luck elsewhere. The following descriptors are fairly general as there's a lot of factors that go into how a wine tastes including the place it's grown, the winemaker's decisions, and, of course, the grape's own natural characteristics. We've also noted the original home of the grape and noted in brackets the famous regions where the grape is just as successful, if not more so.

CHARDONNAY

Home Burgundy (California)

Colour white

Style wide ranging from full bodied and oaky to lean and unoaked

Flavour & aroma green apple, lemon, grapefruit, flint and mineral to roasted nuts, tropical fruit, butter, toast, vanilla, butterscotch

Food pairing (unoaked and crisp) oysters, cream sauces, white fish (oaked and buttery) salmon, lobster, risotto, turkey, veal

SAUVIGNON BLANC

Home Loire/Bordeaux (New Zealand)

Colour white

Style light to medium body, fresh, crisp and high acid

Flavour & aroma grapefruit, gooseberry, herbal (fresh cut grass, asparagus), green pepper, mineral

Food pairings goat cheese, vinaigrettes, oysters, tomato, asparagus

RIESLING

Home Germany/Alsace

Colour white

Style Very wide range from steely and dry to sweet ice wine

Flavours & aromas petrol, slate, flint, lime, peach, apricot, pineapple, honey

Food pairings pâté, smoked fish, spicy dishes, triple crème cheese, sauerkraut, duck confit, choucroute

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Home Bordeaux (California)

Colour red

Style full bodied, rich and powerful

Flavour & aroma blackcurrant, black cherry, cassis, plum, pencil shaving, cedar, tobacco, mint

Food pairing lamb, beef, mushrooms, game, blue cheese

MERLOT

Home Bordeaux

Colour red

Style medium to full bodied, moderate alcohol and soft tannin

Flavours & aromas strawberry, red cherry, raspberry, black currant, plum, baking spice, earth

Food pairings game birds, pate, terrine, lasagna, ham, pizza, salmon, braised chicken (coq au vin)

PINOT NOIR

Home Burgundy

Colour red

Style light bodied, lower tannin, higher acid
Flavour & aromas: strawberry, raspberry, red cherry, earth, forest, dried leaves, cranberry, spice, violet, incense, wood smoke, barnyard, leather, game

Food pairings lean beef, braised chicken, duck, fennel, mushroom, salmon, tuna, veal

CABERNET FRANC

Home Bordeaux/Loire

Colour red

Style medium bodied, rich and savoury

Flavour & aroma savoury bell pepper, tobacco, herbal, raspberry, black cherry, asphalt, lavender

Food pairing roast beef, game, grilled lamb, eggplant, strong cheeses

SYRAH

Home Rhône (Australia as Shiraz)

Colour red

Style: full bodied, powerful, with high alcohol and firm tannin

Flavour & aroma smoke, black pepper, bacon, herbs (rosemary, mint, eucalyptus), black berry, mineral, violet incense, game, leather

Food pairing venison, tuna, steak, sausage, ribs, BBQ, rich pasta
